Shows : August 4 & 5 Auditions: June 26 & 27

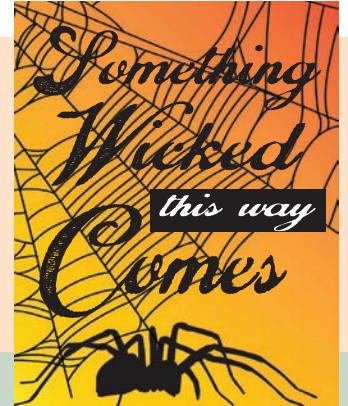

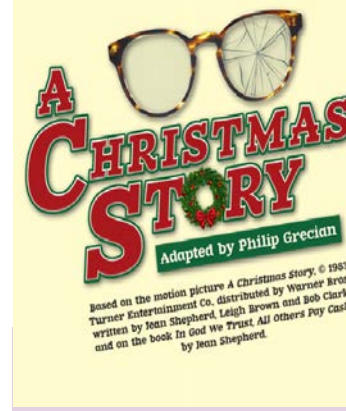


A CHRISTMAS Story

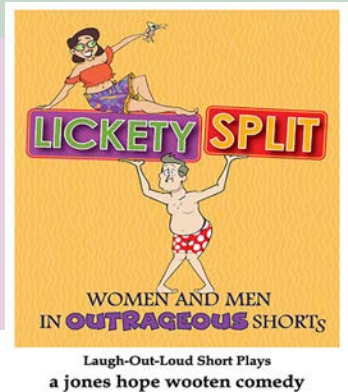


Lickety Split

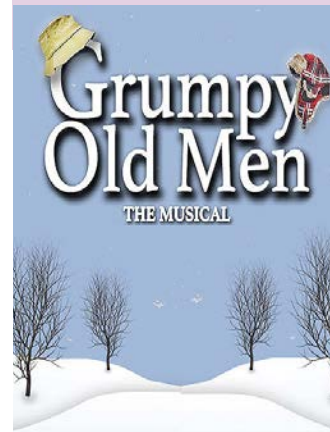


GRUMPY OLD MEN
