Aug. 9, 10, 11, & 16, 17, 18

It's the tail end of the 1980s in Hollywood, and the party has been raging. Dec. 6, 7, 8 & 13, 14, 15

Becka, age 12, and Boomer, eight, are sisters whose parents are in the midst of a separation. Becka is goaded by her hacker friends into telling Boomer that there is no Santa, and when she does, this threatens to ruin Christmas for the family. The parents try to deal with the fallout; then mysterious Mrs. Rosen, arrives and begins to change the equation challenging Becka to prove there is no Santa by using her computer.



April 25, 26, 27 & May 2, 3, 4

Our Town is a play by Thornton Wilder that revolves around life in the small town of Grover's Corners, New Hampshire. Specifically, the play focuses around the lives of George and Emily as they come together, only to be separated in the end.
