Major Improvements Scheduled To Begin

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, supporters and community, Old Town Players rasied an incredible \$82,353 during a major capital fundraising campaign in the spring of 2025. Additional funding of \$50,000 was awarded as a result of our success through a matching grant from the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority's CreatINg Places program.

We are pleased to announce work will begin on Monday, November 3, starting with the replacement of our roof and resurfacing of the veranda to create an enjoyable, outdoor space for our patrons. The auditorium ceiling will be scraped and the ceiling and walls will get a fresh coat of paint in late December. In the spring, we'll move forward with the repair of our eaves and soffits and finish up with some exterior painting.

All work will be completed by local contractors, as OTP is committed to keeping your donations local and supporting the community that has been so generous in its support of us!
