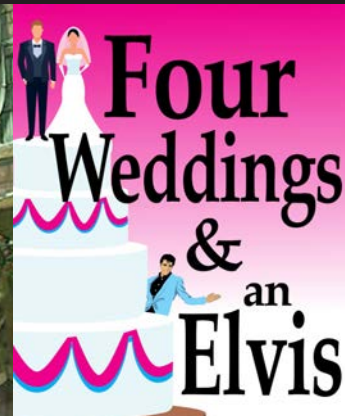
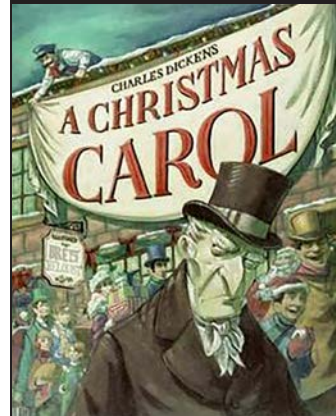

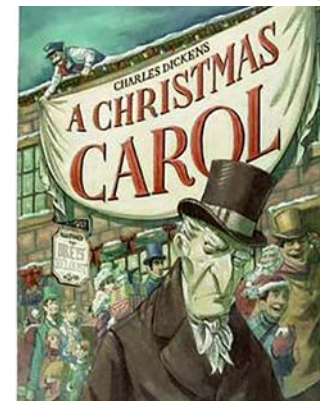

Auditions: October 17-18

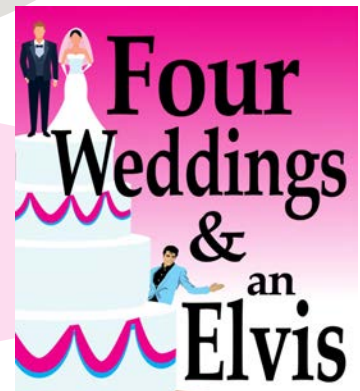

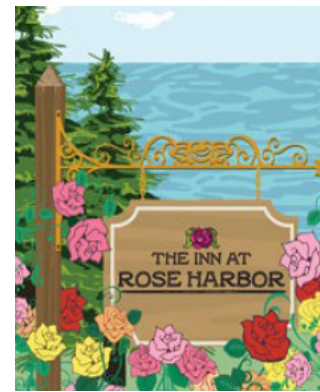


THE INN at ROSE HARBOR
